

GENERAL HIGHLIGHTS

- The Y serves 46% of people in our service area through membership & programs.
- There were 937,470 visits to our facilities, up from 882,187 in 2024.
- We ended the year with a total of 20,760 members.
- We served 35,120 individuals through membership and programs.

- 9,780 kids were served through membership, programs, and services.
- We cared for 2,500+ kids across all our childcare programs.
- We saw an average of 360 kids per day in our 3 childcare centers.
- Kids got active in youth sports programs 3,493 times.
- 424 kids attended summer camp programs.
- Kids took to the court for tennis lessons 724 times.
- Our youth ice & hockey programs had 461 participations.
- Our staff guided swimmers in our pools across 3,817 swim lesson enrollments.

HEALTHY LIVING

- There were 318,892 visits to our two Health and Wellness centers.
- Our studios were buzzing with 88,680 visits to group exercise.
- Over 1,260 youth & adults participated in 2,192 tennis lessons.

- 900 people participated in open pickleball, leagues, lessons, & clinics over 3,000 times.
- Chronic disease prevention programs for Parkinson's & cancer survivors saw 82 enrollments.
- Adults got active in sports programs 1,250 times, strengthening both physical & social well-being.
- The Teaching Kitchen hosted 45 programs serving ages 2-92.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- We made health & wellness easier for military members & their families, impacting 1,077 people.
- 600+ children received life-saving Safety Around Water training.
- We cared for 1,242 kids in our short-term Child Watch centers, helping parents focus on their health & wellness 5,395 times.
- We welcomed 3,816 visits at our 8 free community nights.
- 16 people found hope after a loss through the Brighter Days program.
- 1,000+ volunteers and 30+ community partnerships helped us power events and programs.
- We provided \$400,320 in subsidized memberships for seniors, ensuring that people 55+ have a place to connect and belong.
- We provided \$420,921 in assistance to make quality childcare possible for local families.
- Through the generosity of our donors, we awarded \$411,445 in membership assistance. More than half of the recipients were children.
- Overall, the Oshkosh YMCA awarded more than \$1.7 million in assistance and community benefits in 2025.
